

Meet the Senior Pastor Kyle Doebler

Originally from Richmond, Virginia, Kyle Doebler comes to Hamilton Square having served churches in San Francisco, New Jersey, and Ohio. He is a graduate of Princeton Theological Seminary (Master of Divinity) and the College of William and Mary (economics and mathematics).

After college, Kyle worked on the West Coast as a litigation consultant, specializing in Native American and complex financial litigation. Shortly after beginning his consulting career, however, he experienced a renewal of faith and began discerning a call to ministry.

Most recently, Kyle served as Associate Pastor of Liberty Presbyterian Church, near Columbus, Ohio. While at Liberty, he developed both local and international mission partnerships, and he led a new member ministry that welcomed an average of fifty new members annually. In addition, he taught and developed adult classes, creating an all-church “year through the Bible” program that was used by hundreds of people each week.

Kyle met his wife, Krystal, while they were both students at William and Mary. Krystal is a CPA and a Senior Manager in KPMG’s federal tax practice in Philadelphia, focusing on real estate, partnerships, and private equity.



Together, Kyle and Krystal enjoy cooking, traveling, running, hiking, and road biking, and they are excited to make the Hamilton area and First Presbyterian Church their home.
